





## Is This Being Recorded? An Evening with Former Federal Prosecutor Eric Berg Princeton '01 at the Princeton Club

His career with the DOJ focused on the use of electronic surveillance in criminal investigations aimed at the prosecution of organized crime, violent crimes, corruption, the misappropriation of public funds, and drug trafficking.
